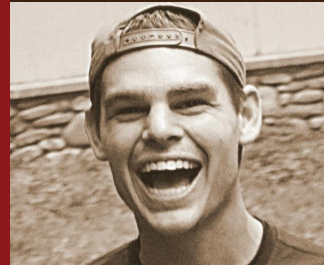

WESLEY WILSON- SHAWNEE



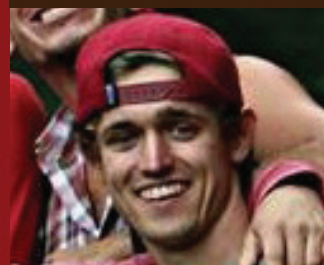
JOSH TILLERY- CHOCTAW
