

CAMPER PACKING LIST

Below is a checklist you can use as a guideline to pack your daughter's trunk. This is a suggested list, not mandatory. You may want to add a few things or leave out others, but you can use it to get started.

WHAT TO PACK

- 10 t-shirts or tops
- 10 pairs of shorts
- 2 pairs of pants/leggings
- 2 sweatshirts
- 10 day supply of underwear
- 8 pairs of socks
- 2 long tube socks for Sock War
- Pajamas
- 2 full-coverage bathing suits (one piece or tankini)
- 1 white shirt (for Council of Progress)
- 1 pair of green shorts (for Council of Progress)
- 2 pairs of tennis shoes
- 1 pair of shoes/sandals that can get wet
- 1 outfit for Sunday Worship
- 1 rain jacket
- 1 set of bed sheets (cot-sized mattress)
- 2 pillow cases
- Pillow
- 1-2 blankets
- 1 sleeping bag (Hawksbill, Cumberland, Roan, and Bluerock only)
- 3 towels (2 bath, 1 swimming)
- Toiletries
- Laundry bag
- Bible
- Journal
- Stationary/stamps
- Flashlight
- Water bottle
- Backpack
- Honor Bands (returning campers)
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Small battery powered clip on fan (optional)

*No flip flops are to be worn outside of the cabins.

*Please make sure all clothing covers camper's abdomen, back, bottom, and chest.

WHAT NOT TO PACK

- Costly cameras*
- Cell phones*
- iPods
- Gaming Devices
- Tablets
- E-readers
- Smart Watches
- Expensive jewelry
- Any other expensive or valuable items
- Books with suggestive content (i.e. Colleen Hoover)

We are trying to preserve a wholesome, rustic, outdoor atmosphere at Camp. The above items seem to only distract from this setting. Should the camper come with one of these items, they will be kept in the office and returned when the camper departs.

*The only exception to the cell phone policy is if your child is flying to or from Camp. In this case, we will keep the cell phone in an office safe and return it to her on Closing Day. If a cell phone is found in a camper's possession during the session, a \$300 fee will be charged to the camper's Camp In Touch account.

*Cameras are allowed at Crestridge, but pictures are not allowed to be taken inside of cabins. If pictures are taken inside cabins, the camera will be held in the Bear Trap until Closing Day.
